**RETROACTIVE REQUEST TO ACCEPT DONATION OF 96 BREAST PUMPS FROM ORANGE
COUNTY BLACK INFANT HEALTH PROGRAM

The purpose of this letter is to request your Board's approval of the retroactive request to accept the donation of 96 electric breast pumps from Orange County Black Infant Health program, in an estimated value of \$13,200. This item is retroactive due to a misunderstanding of the requirement for approval of donations.

The department received a donation of 96 electric breast pumps from Orange County Black Infant Health program in June of 2023. These breast pumps have an estimated value of \$13,200 collectively, and therefore, in accordance with Administrative Bulletin No. 13, require your Board's approval to accept. The intent of the donation of these electric breast pumps is to distribute them to our maternal, child and adolescent health program recipients to encourage breast feeding.

Therefore, IT IS RECOMMENDED your Board approve the retroactive request to accept the donation of 96 electric breast pumps from Orange County Black Infant Health program, in an estimated value of \$13,200, and authorize the Chairman to sign the letter of appreciation.
