**REQUEST TO ACCEPT DONATION FROM EDISON INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION
AND APPROPRIATE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE**

(Fiscal Impact: \$20,000; Donation; Not Budgeted; Discretionary)

Aging and Adult Services Department is pleased to announce a generous donation of \$20,000 from Edison International Foundation, designated for the Title III C2 home delivered meals program.

The home-delivered meals program, commonly known as the "Meals on Wheels" program, provides meals from Monday through Friday. Meals can be delivered either as a daily warm meal drop-off or through a weekly frozen delivery. These home-delivered meals are available to people 60 years or older who are homebound (by reason of illness, incapacitation, disability or isolation) and unable to leave their homes to participate in the congregate meal locations (Senior Centers). The program supports older adults through both a nutritious third of their daily recommended caloric intake and regular interactions with drivers and program staff.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to Edison International Foundation for their generosity and support of our "Meals on Wheels" program.

Revenue will be recognized under cost center 1631CC revenue category ID 1541RC. Expenditures will be recognized under spend category ID 1050SC.

The County Administrative Office has reviewed and concurs with this request.

Therefore, IT IS RECOMMENDED that your Board accept a donation of \$20,000 from Edison International Foundation; approve appropriation of unanticipated revenue; authorize Auditor-Controller to process specified budgetary adjustments and accounting transactions; and authorize the Chair to sign a letter of appreciation to Edison International Foundation.
